TRAIN allows us to deliver organized, cost-effective educational programs and training courses using a variety of formats, such as face- to-face, webinar, webcast and online modules.

EWD Branch is seeking a Registered Nurse with strong interpersonal skills, a self-starter with adult learning expertise. This nurse will assist in the development of trainings to qualify for Kentucky Board of Nursing Continuing Education Credits.

Responsibilities and duties:

- Oversees the department's Kentucky Board of Nursing (KBN) continuing education and other workforce credentialing programs.
- Interprets statutes, regulations, guidelines and rulings regarding nursing and nursing continuing education.
- Promotes continuing education program through consultation with course providers and subject matter experts.
- Serves as a resource consultant to programs of nursing and development of training.
- Assesses course offerings to ensure compliance with standards set forth by the Council on Linkages, Core Competencies for Public Health Professionals and CDC Quality Training Standards.
- Review and analyze the evaluation summaries of courses per KBN guidelines and develop tools useful for corrections as needed.
- Fosters the use of these standards & guidelines by all course providers.

EDUCATION: Graduate of a college or university with a master's degree in nursing.

EXPERIENCE, TRAINING, OR SKILLS: Must have five years of experience in teaching or administration of schools of nursing, nursing practice and/or nursing supervision, nursing administration or continuing nursing education programs.
