

The Barren River District Health Department is accepting applications for a full time **Public Health Director IV.**

General Duties Include: This position serves at the discretion of the District Board of Health and the Commissioner for Public Health. Responsibilities for the position include direction of personnel of an 8 (eight) county District Health Department. Serves as the appointing authority. Provides direction for a variety of public health programs and services provided within the service area such as medical, environmental, health education, disaster preparedness, oral health, and support services. Performs/directs a variety of administrative tasks such as budget planning, financial management, setting performance standards, and measuring performance of staff. Through collaboration with partner agencies and using a community health assessment, analyzes the health status of counties within the service area, and works with community partners to identify key areas of focus for service delivery and population health improvement. Has a close working relationship with state agencies, which provide direction and technical assistance and support. Ensures programs and activities incorporate the Core Public Health Functions, as well as the Ten Essential Services of Public Health as evidenced by recognition from the Public Health Accreditation Board. May serve as secretary to the Board of Health.

Minimum Education, Training and Experience Requirements: Master's degree from an accredited college or university in Business, Public or Health Administration, Public or Community Health, Nursing, Social Science, Education or other related degree. Must have seven (7) years of experience in Public Health or other health related occupations, five (5) years of which must have been in a supervisory or management capacity.
